AFFILIATION SUPPORT

- Affiliation to CUPE Ontario is set at .04%
- Non Affiliated locals pay a higher fee to attend CUPE Ontario events
 - Credit from higher fee used toward PCT if local decides to affiliate
- Non Affiliated locals:
 - Cannot access small local subsidy or Scholarship Fund
 - Cannot serve on a committee or attend convention

LOCAL ASSISTANT FUND

- Small Local Subsidy for events
 - Application to be submitted by timeline
 - Enclosures include: latest trustees report, bank statement (less than 10x the assets)
- Convention Assistance
 - Not available if locals sending multiple delegates
 - Limited to waived registration fee & travel

ACCESSIBILITY SUPPORT AT EVENTS

- Accessibility Audits of venues
- Accessibility Liaison onsite
- Accessibility supports available upon request by deadline:
 - Translation (including ASL interpretation)
 - Child Care
 - Scooters
 - Quiet Rooms
 - Large Font/laptops/electronic material
 - Other requests as identified and requested

CUPE ONTARIO COMMITTEES

- Multiple Committees & Working Groups lead by CUPE members
- All expenses for participation covered by CUPE Ontario
- All Committees elected at a relevant conference
- Per diem & Travel advances available

NATIONAL DEFENCE FUND

- Resources from CUPE National to carry out campaigns in the region (100% dollars)
- Limited resources available to directly support locals
- Opportunities for book off & integration with local campaigns
- NDF Campaign includes but isn't limited to:
 - Equality work
 - Member Mobilization
 - H&S/Injured workers
 - Sector campaigns
 - Building the Base (member mobilization focussed)

ANTI-PRIVATIZATION FUND

- 100% dollars from CUPE National
- Used for the sole purpose of fighting privatization, contracting out and bringing work back in house
- Multi-Sector Fightback line available to assist locals
 - Contact CUPE Ontario
 - Outline the fight and plan details
 - Include budget request
 - If available support can be provided
